

MOUNTAIN LAKE ACADEMY EDUCATIONAL REOPENING PLAN

This document is intended to communicate specific components of Mountain Lake Academy educational plans for reopening in September 2020. This plan is to be used in conjunction with the Covid Reopening Plan (attached). The Mountain Lake Academy Educational Reopening Plan offers families, districts, and students three options for instruction based on COVID-19 regional needs and contains the structure for in-person instruction model, a hybrid model, and a remote instruction model. Mountain Lake Academy will continue to monitor all procedures and practices to ensure the health and safety of all.

- o **In-Person Instruction:** Mountain Lake Academy will provide in-person instruction for all students who reside on campus during the academic calendar year. Classrooms will have a maximum number of students and staff to ensure that the amount of square footage per person is no more than 20.
- **Hybrid Model:** If Mountain Lake Academy has students both on-campus and off-campus due to COVID-19, a hybrid of in-person instruction and remote instruction will occur.
- Remote Instruction: In the case of student(s) who are off-campus, remote instruction will be
 provided to those student(s). This will include students who are not on campus due to the
 closure of Mountain Lake Academy; parent, county, and/or school requests to provide remote
 instruction; and/or students who are isolated/quarantined due to COVID-19 infection,
 signs/symptoms, or potential exposure.
