## Parents' Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security

The Mountain Lake Children's Residence, Inc. is committed to protecting the privacy and security of each students' data. Parents/legal guardians should be aware of the following rights concerning their child's data:

- 1. A student's personally identifiable information (PII) cannot be sold or released for any commercial purpose.
- 2. Parents/legal guardians have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of the student's education record stored or maintained by an educational agency.
- Safeguards associated with industry standards and best practices including but not limited to encryption, firewalls and password protection must be in place when student PII is stored or transferred.
- 4. To be notified in accordance with applicable laws and regulations if a breach or unauthorized release of their student's PII occurs.
- 5. Educational agency workers that handle PII will receive training on applicable state and federal laws, the educational agency's policies, and safeguards associated with industry standards and best practices.
- 6. Parents/legal guardians have the right to file complaints with the school about possible breaches, these should be directed to:
